CHAPTER XXXIX.

An ACT for the further Regulation of the Borough of Pitt/burgh.

Section 1. E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the inhabitants of the bo-who shall be rough of Pittsburgh, who shall have resided entitled to vote within the same six months immediately pre-officers. ceding the election, and who shall in other respects be entitled to vote for members of the General Assembly, shall be fully competent to vote at the elections of officers for said borough.
