CHAPTER LXXV.

An ACT for the speedy Redemption of certain Certificates therein mentioned.

WHEREAS by an act, entitled, "An act to compenfate David Meade and others," paffed the ninth day of March, one thoufand feven hundred and ninety-fix, certain certificates were iffued as evidences of credits in favor of the faid David Meade and others; and as a part of the debt created by the faid certificates remains unpaid, and as juffice to individuals, as well as the interest of the State, requires that it fhould be fpeedily extinguished : Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is bereby
