### CHAPTER LXXIX.

#### An ACT declaring Wyalufing Creek a public Highway.

Section 1. D E it enacted by the Senate and Houfe of Reprefentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennfylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, That all that part of Wyalufing creek de- lufing creek, fituate between the mouth thereof and Picket's mill, near the forks of faid creek, be and the fame is hereby declared a public highway for the paffage of boats and rafts, and it shall and may be lawful for perfons defirous of using the navigation of faid creek, to remove all natural and artificial obstructions; and to erect fuch flopes and locks at the mill dams now built as may be neceffary for the paffage of boats and rafts: Provided, Such flopes and locks fhall be fo conftructed as not to injure the works of faid dams.
