## CHAPTER LXXXI.

*An ACT declaring Parts of the Branches of Pine Creek, in the Counties of Tioga and Potter, public Highways.*

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the west branch of Pine creek from the third fork, in the county of Tioga, to the forks at the Elk-Lick, in the county of Potter, and also the said third fork from its mouth to Morris's marsh, in the said county of Tioga, shall be, and the same are hereby declared to be public highways, for the passage of boats and rafts, and it shall and may be lawful for the inhabitants, and others desirous of using the navigation

ral or other obstructions in the same: *Provided*

this Commonwealth, passed on the twenty-third  
day of March, one thousand eight hundred and  
three, entitled, "An act to authorise any person  
or persons owning lands adjoining navigable  
streams of water, declared public highways, to  
erect dams upon such streams for mills and other  
water-works."
