CHAPTER CXXXI.

*An ACT to establish a public ferry over Swatara creek, near its junction with the river Susquehanna, in the county of Dauphin, and for vesting the right in John Gregg, his heirs and assigns.*

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful from and after the passing of this act, for John Gregg, his heirs and assigns at his and their own proper cost and charges, to make or cause to be made good and convenient landings upon

both sides of Swatara creek, on the main road leading from Middletown, in Dauphin county to York town, in the county of York, where he at present keeps a ferry, and shall at all times hereafter maintain the same in good order and repair, fit for men, horses and carriages to pass and repass, and further the said John Gregg, his heirs and assigns shall provide and maintain a good and substantial boat or boats and careful ferry-men, who shall duly and constantly as occasion may require, attend for the purpose of transporting travellers and others over the said creek, which ferry shall be subject to such rules, rates and regulations as the court of quarter sessions for the county of Dauphin, may in future direct and appoint: *Provided always*, That nothing in this act contained shall be construed to vest in John Gregg, his heirs and assigns a right to land any boat or boats upon any landing belonging to any other persons without their consent first had and obtained.
