### CHAPTER CXXXIX.

An ACT to encourage the killing of Wolves.

Section. 1. BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the fame, That from and after the Premium alpaffing of this act, any perfon or perfons who lowed for killfhall kill any wolf or wolves within the bounds of any county within this commonwealth, and who shall produce the head or heads thereof before any justice of the peace, in, and for any county as aforefaid, it shall be the duty of fuch justice to examine fuch perfon or perfons on oath or affirmation, touching the time when, and place, where fuch wolf or wolves was or were caught and killed, and if the place of fuch catching and killing, fhall be found to be within the bounds of the county, in which fuch justice has jurifdiction, and if the wolf be full grown, it then shall be the duty of fuch justice. after deftroying fuch head or heads, to give fuch perfon or perfons a certificate of the facts to the commissioners of the county, who shall draw their order for eight dollars on the treafurer of the county, in which it shall have appeared, fuch wolf or wolves was or were caught and killed for each and every head produced and deftroyed as before mentioned; and for every wolf puppy that shall be produced and deftroyed as before mentioned, he shall certify to the commissioners as aforefaid, who shall draw their order on the treasurer aforefaid, for the fum of three dollars; and it shall be the duty of fuch treafurer, and he is hereby directed to pay the amount of the faid order out of the money

# money in the treasury appropriated for county purposes.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted by the auformer act te-thority aforefaid, That the act, entitled, "An pealed. act more effectually to encourage the killing of wolves," patfed the thirteenth of April, one thousand feven hundred and eighty-two, is hereby repealed.
