## CHAPTER CLXXX.

An ACT for the relief of non-refident Owners of. Lands, in Sugar-Creek Town/hip, Venango county.

HEREAS it appears by a petition from the commiffioners and auditors of the county of Crawford, that the fupervilors of Sugar-creek township, did in the year one thousand eight hundred and three, affels a road tax for the faid township of one thousand fix hundred and eighty-nine dollars, which road tax is conceived by the petitioners to be exorbitant and oppreffive, and much higher than the nature of the cafe required: For remedy whereof,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennfylvania, in General Affembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, That the commissioners of Crawford county, be, and county author they are hereby authorifed, to reduce the tax rifed to reduce affeffed on the unfeated lands in the township fented lands in aforefaid, fo as to equalife the fame, as nearly as may be, with the taxes affeffed in the adjoining township, having regard to the quality of the lands in faid township, and the expenses necesfary in the fame, for laying out, opening and repairing the roads therein.
