CHAPTER LXIV.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act entitled “An act to erect the Town of Canonsburgh in the County of Washington, into a Borough.”

SECTION I. *BE* it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the time for holding the election of borough officers, as directed by the act of incorporation of said borough, be changed from the first Monday of May to the third Saturday of March, in each and every year hereafter.

SECT. II. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the law of the borough aforesaid, which prohibits hogs running at large, be, and the same is hereby confirmed, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
