

making any alteration in the route of said road, the court should approve and confirm the same, a draft of the courses and distances of such alteration shall be filed in the office of the clerk of said court, and a duplicate thereof transmitted to the secretary of the commonwealth, and the said road so laid out shall thereafter be part of the state road aforesaid, and that part rendered unnecessary thereby shall be vacated, and the expence of the viewers shall be paid by warrants drawn by the commissioners on the treasury of Indiana county.

CHAPTER XXV.

*An ACT for the Relief of Nathaniel Coulter.*

WHEREAS it appears that Nathaniel Coulter of the county of Washington, in the years one thousand seven hundred and eighty-one, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-two and one thousand seven hundred and eighty-three, performed several tours of militia duty in defence of the Western frontier of this State, against the hostile attacks of the Indians, for which he neither received pay nor rations. And as it is but just and reasonable that the services which were rendered in defence of the Commonwealth, during the period of our revolutionary contest, should be amply compensated: Therefore,

SECTION. I. *BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That there be, and is hereby granted to Nathaniel Coulter, sixty dollars in full for his military services, which shall be paid to him or his proper attorney, out of any unappropriated monies in the treasury, on a warrant drawn by the Governor as is usual in others cases.*
