## AN ACT

To empower the Public Service Commission to require railroad corporations to employ an adequate number of men upon trains; and to repeal an act, approved the nineteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws, ten hundred and fifty-three), entitled "An act to promote the safety of travelers and employes upon railroads, by compelling common carriers by rail-road to properly man their trains."

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Public Serv- Railroads. ice Commission, created by the Public Service Com- Public Service pany Law, approved July twenty-sixth, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen (Pamphlet Laws, thirteen hundred and seventy-four), shall have power, after hearing upon notice, by order in writing, to require any railroad corporation, as defined in the Public Service Company Law, to employ such number of men Adequacy of rail-upon any of its trains as in the judgment of the com- road crews. mission is requisite for the safe and efficient operation thereof, and any such order shall be enforceable and Enforcement and reviewable in the same manner as prescribed by such Public Service Company Law, and the amendments thereto, in respect to orders of the commission made thereunder; and all acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, including the act of June nineteenth, Full Crew Law of one thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet 1053), repealed.
