AN ACT

To amend section fifteen of an act, approved April twenty-seventh, one thousand nine hundred and five (Pamphlet Laws, three hundred and twelve, entitled "An act creating a Department of Health, and defining its powers and duties," as amended.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section fifteen Department of Health. of the act, approved the twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred and five (Pamphlet Laws, three hundred and twelve), entitled "An act creating a Department of Health, and defining its powers and duties," which, as amended by the act, approved the seventeenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, entitled "An act to amend an act, approved April twenty-seventh, one thousand nine hundred and five, entitled 'An act creating a Department of Health, and defining its powers and duties,' by providing for an official seal, directing the Commissioner of Health to certify orders and regulations under seal, and making such certificates evidence in courts, and providing for the promulgation of advisory board orders and regulations," reads as follows:---

L. 312), as amended by act partment of Health shall be promulgated by sending printed copies to all local boards of health, clerks of councils of cities and boroughs, and county superintendents of public schools, and by printing once in at least one daily paper of the city of Philadelphia and one of Pittsburgh, and the orders and regulations shall be printed in circular form and given to any one who demands them," be amended to read as follows:-

Section 15. All orders and regulations of the Department of Health shall be promulgated by sending printed copies to all local boards of health, clerks of councils of cities and boroughs, and county superintendents of public schools, and by printing, once a week for two weeks in not more than one daily paper in the city of Philadelphia and one of Pittsburgh and one of Harrisburg, and the orders and regulations shall be printed in circular form, and given to any one who demands them.
