AN ACT

To amend the forty-first clause of section two, article one, chapter five, of the act, approved the fourteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen (Pamphlet Laws, three hundred twelve), entitled "An act providing a system of government for boroughs, and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating to boroughs."

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the forty-first clause of section two, article one, chapter five, of the act, approved the fourteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, entitled "An act providing a system of government for boroughs, and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," which by amendment of said act reads as follows:—

"XLI. To appropriate money for the expense of municipal music," is hereby amended to read as follows:—

XLI. To appropriate money, *not in excess of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) annually*, for the expense of municipal music.
