istrative boards with regard to the expenditure of money and prescribing the duties of departmental administrative boards with reference to the making of financial reports, the furnishing of financial and budgetary information to the department with which it is connected, and the making of biennial reports.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Governor to appoint a Commission to complete the printing of the report prepared by the Old Age Assistance Commission; and making an appropriation.

Section 1. Be is enacted, &c., That the Governor appoint a commission of three to wind up the affairs of the Old Age Assistance Commission, to complete the printing of the report of its findings, and to so arrange its data as to make it available for public distribution.

Section 2. An appropriation of two thousand dollars (\$2,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically made to the commission thus appointed by the Governor, for the purpose of paying for the printing and clerical and other expenses necessary to do the work provided for in section one of this act.
