AN ACT

Fixing the pay of election officers and clerks in counties of the second class.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That at all elections in counties of the second class the pay of judges of election shall be fifteen dollars per day, and the pay of inspectors and clerks shall be ten dollars per day.

AN ACT

Authorizing counties, cities, boroughs, incorporated towns, town-ships, and school districts to make contracts of insurance with mutual fire insurance companies duly authorized to transact business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That any county, city, borough, incorporated town, township, school district, or poor district may make contracts of insurance with any mutual fire insurance company duly authorized by law to transact business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on any building or property owned by such county, city, borough, incorporated town, township, school district, or poor district.

Municipalities.

May make con-tracts of insurance with mutual fire insurance companies.

Section 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent Repeal. herewith are hereby repealed.
