## AN ACT

To amend section one of the act, approved the twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (Pamphlet Laws, thirty-two), entitled "An act conferring equity jurisdiction upon the courts of common pleas in all cases of the mortgages of the property or franchises of coal, iron, steel, lumber or oil, or mining, manufacturing or transportation companies," extending the provisions of the act to all corporations.

Enforcement of rights under mortgages of corporations. Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section one of the act, approved the twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (Pamphlet Laws, thirty-two), entitled "An act conferring equity jurisdiction upon the courts of common pleas in all cases of the mortgages of the property or franchises of coal, iron, steel, lumber or oil, or mining, manufacturing or transportation companies," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That each of the several courts of common pleas of this Commonwealth shall have and exercise all the powers of a court of chancery, in all cases of or for enforcing rights under mortgages of the property or franchises of any [coal, iron, steel, lumber or oil, or any mining, manufacturing or transportation] corporation, where such property or franchises, or any part thereof, shall be situate or exercisable within the limits of this Commonwealth, and belong to or be exercisable by any domestic corporation or any foreign corporation under permission granted by the laws of this Commonwealth.

## AN ACT

To amend sections three and nine of the act, approved the second day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twentynine (Pamphlet Laws, one thousand five hundred thirty), entitled "An act relating to the erection of a dam at the outlet of Pymatuning Swamp, and the establishment of a reservoir for the flood control of the Shenango and Beaver Rivers; conferring and continuing certain powers and duties on the Department of Forests and Waters in relation to the establishment and maintenance of such reservoir; providing for the acquisition of necessary lands therefor, and the necessary agreements and releases relating thereto, and the disposition of surplus land and materials," by authorizing the development of the fishing, hunting, and other recreational resources thereof and in cident thereto, and conferring additional powers on the Water and Power Resources Board.
