Section 2. The jurisdiction so ceded to the United States of America is granted upon the express condition that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania shall retain a concurrent jurisdiction with the United States, in and over the tracts of land aforesaid, so far that civil process in all cases, and such criminal process as may issue under the authority of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania against any person or persons charged with the crimes committed without the said tracts of land, may be executed thereon in the same way and manner as if this jurisdiction had not been ceded. The United States are to retain such jurisdiction as long as said tract of land shall be used for the purposes expressed in the foregoing section, and no longer.

Section 3. This act shall be effective upon the date

of its approval by the Governor.

AN ACT

According to the United States Commissioner of Fisheries, and his agents, the right to conduct fish hatching and fish culture at a fish-cultural station established by the United States within the Commonwealth.

U.S. Fish-Cultural Station. Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby gives its consent and accords to the Government of the United States and the

United States Commissioner of Fisheries, and his duly consent of authorized agents, the right to establish a fish-cultural station in this Commonwealth, and to conduct fish hatching and fish culture at said hatchery in any manner and at any time the said commissioner may consider necessary and proper.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Forests and Waters in certain instances, and with the approval of the Governor, to construct, improve or repair, at the expense of the Commonwealth, portions of roads or highways connecting roads or highways lying within areas of State forest lands with State, county or township roads or highways near such areas.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Department Department of Forests and Waters is hereby authorized to construct, of Forests and Waters. improve or repair, at the expense of the Commonwealth, any portion of a road or highway connecting a road or Connecting roads highway lying within the area of a State forest with state forests. any State, county or township road or highway not lying within the area of a State forest whenever such connection is deemed necessary by the Department of Forests and Waters for the development, protection or use by the public of any State forests now owned or hereafter acquired by the Commonwealth. The Department of Forests and Waters is hereby authorized and empowered to construct, improve or repair any such construction connecting road or highway by the employes of such department.

Section 2. Before the Department of Forests and Plan to De Waters shall proceed to construct, improve or repair prepared. any such road or highway, the Secretary of Forests and Waters shall cause to be prepared a plan or draft of such connecting road or highway, showing concisely the construction, improvement or repair which, in his judgment, is necessary under the provisions of this act, and shall submit such plan or draft to the Governor for his Approval approval before any expenditure of State moneys is by Governor. authorized for the contemplated construction, improve-

Section 3. Nothing in this act shall relieve the county, county township or district, wherein such road or highway is located, from its responsibility for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance, improvement, repair and supervision thereof, except as the construction, improve-

ment or repair.
