To amend section fourteen of the act, approved the twelfth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, four hundred sixty six), entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of cooperative agricultural associations not having a capital stock and not conducted for profit, and defining agriculture so as to include persons engaged in agriculture, dairying, livestock raising, poultry raising, bee-keeping, and horticulture," as amended.

Section 1. Section 14. The board of directors of each association shall consist of not less than five members. At the first regular meeting of the association, a quorum as specified by the by-laws being present, the members shall elect from among themselves directors for the term of one year. At the expiration of the terms of directors so elected, their successors shall be elected in like manner for terms of one year: Provided, That certain directors may [at the first regular meeting of a newly organized association, or in the case of associations already existing, then at the first meeting held for election purposes after this amendment becomes effective, be elected for terms longer than one year, so that thereafter one-third, as nearly as possible, of such directors may be elected every year for terms of three years. Directors shall hold office until their successors have been elected and qualified and until their successors shall enter upon the discharge of their duties. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired terms at any regular meeting or at any special meeting called for the purpose by the board of directors. The board of directors shall manage the affairs of the association, and shall perform such other duties as may be specifically imposed upon the board by this act.

## No. 103 AN ACT

To amend section eleven of the act, approved the twenty-seventh day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three (Pamphlet Laws, thirty-four), entitled "An act concerning alcoholic liquors; prohibiting the manufacture, advertising, furnishing, traffic in, and possession of intoxicating liquors for beverage purposes, and articles and substances designed or intended for use in the manufacture thereof; defining intoxicating liquor; providing for penalties, forfeitures, and the abatement of nuisances; and repealing existing alcoholic liquor laws and alcoholic liquor license laws," providing for the payment to the holder of a chattel mortgage or conditional sale contract of the money due under such mortgage or contract from the proceeds of the sale of any vehicle or conveyance seized under said act, and giving to such mortgagee or conditional seller the same rights as are given by said act to the holder of a bailment lease.
