Validating the action of the salary boards, in counties of the third class, in providing additional assistants to the district attorneys in the respective counties, when such appointments became necessary on account of sickness of assistant district attorneys, or on account of increased business or unusual conditions or circumstances, provided the salary of such appointees did not exceed the minimum salary provided for assistant district attorneys in the respective counties,

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That whenever, here-tofore, the salary board in any county of the third class has authorized the appointment of additional assistant district attorneys, in the respective counties, on account of illness of any of the regularly appointed assistant district attorneys, or on account of unusual circumstances or conditions or increased business arising in the office of the district attorney of such county, when the salary stipulated does not exceed the minimum salary provided for assistant district attorneys in the respective counties, the action of the salary board is hereby ratified, approved, and validated.

All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

No. 315 AN ACT

Validating the action of the salary board of any county of the third class of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania when, because of increased business or unusual circumstances or conditions, it has authorized the district attorney to appoint a chief county detective and such additional assistant county detectives as it deemed necessary, and fixed the salaries of all such detectives.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That whenever, heretofore, the salary board of any county of the third class of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, on account of increased business or unusual circumstances or conditions, has authorized the district attorney to appoint a chief county detective and such number of additional assistant county detectives as it deemed necessary and proper, and has fixed the salaries of all such detectives, such action is hereby ratified, validated, and approved.

Section 2. All other acts inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
