the said twenty-first judicial district, to serve until the first Monday of January succeeding the next municipal election.

When effective.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately upon its final enactment.

## AN ACT

To amend the act, approved the second day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine (Pamphlet Laws, one thousand two hundred seventy-eight), entitled "An act relating to counties of the second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; and revising, amending and consolidating the laws relating thereto," by authorizing the district attorney in counties of the third class to purchase and maintain police radio equipment.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the act, approved the second day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine (Pamphlet Laws, one thousand two hundred seventy-eight), entitled "An act relating to counties of the second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; and revising, amending and consolidating the laws relating thereto," is hereby amended by adding, after section two hundred and fifty thereof, a new section to read as follows:

Police radio.

Section 251. Police Radio in Third Class Counties.— The district attorney of any county of the third class may, with the consent and approval of the county commissioners, at the expense of the county, purchase and maintain a short wave police radio receiving and transmitting set, and the necessary equipment therefor, to be installed and used in the office provided for the district attorney.

When effective.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately upon final enactment.
