# AN ACT

To provide for the expenses of the extraordinary session of the Legislature assembled December first, Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, in pursuance of the proclamation of the Governor, dated November twenty-fifth, Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, and the supplement thereto, dated December first, Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred thirty-six.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the following sums, or as much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby specifically appropriated for the payment of the expenses of the Legislature assembled in extraordinary session the first day of December, Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, in pursuance of the proclamation of the Governor, dated the twentyfifth day of November, Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, and the supplement thereto, dated the first day of December, Anno Domini one thousand nine hundred thirty-six.

#### TO THE SENATE

The total sum of forty-one thousand four hundred dollars (\$41,400), or as much thereof as may be necessary, to be paid in the manner prescribed by law—

For the payment of the salaries of the Senators and extra compensation allowed by law to the President pro tempore of the Senate;

For the payment of the mileage of the Senators;

For the payment of the postage allowed by law to each Senator;

For the payment of the salaries of the officers and employes of the Senate during and for the completion of the work of the extraordinary session, also for the payment of the mileage of the officers and employes of the Senate;

For the contingent expenses including extra clerical and stenographic charges of the President pro tempore of the Senate during the period of the extraordinary session, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100), or as much thereof as may be necessary, and for the payment of the necessary expenses including extra labor in the office of the chief clerk during the extraordinary session the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary.

### TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

The total sum of one hundred thirty-six thousand two hundred dollars (\$136,200), or as much thereof as may be necessary, to be paid in the manner prescribed by law—

For the payment of the salaries of the members of the House of Representatives and extra compensation allowed by law to the Speaker of the House;

For the payment of mileage of the members;

For the postage allowed by law to each member;

For the payment of the salaries of the officers and employes of the House of Representatives during and for the completion of the work of the extraordinary session, also for the payment of the mileage of the officers and employes of the House of Representatives;

For the payment of the necessary expenses including extra labor in the office of the chief clerk during the extraordinary session the sum of one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200), or as much thereof as may be necessary.

## LEGISLATIVE JOURNAL

For payment to the chief clerk of the Senate and chief clerk of the House of Representatives for making indices of the journal of each house for the extraordinary session the sum of fifty dollars (\$50) each, one hundred dollars (\$100);

For the work of the Legislative Journal officials after the close of the extraordinary session on the Legislative Journal, also proof reading of appendix and index thereto as provided by law the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100);

For the payment of the person or persons appointed to index the Legislative Journal of the extraordinary session, in accordance with the act establishing said journal, the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100).
