AN ACT

Reducing, for a limited period of time, the training period of internship in osteopathic hospitals, in order to qualify for examination for license by the Osteopathic Surgeons' Examining Board to practice major surgery, and suspending inconsistent laws.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Osteopathic hospitals.

Section 1. For the duration of the present war between the United States and any foreign country and one year after the cessation of hostilities, a minimum of nine months for each year's required internship shall constitute the necessary legal training for an intern in an osteopathic hospital, approved for intern training, to qualify for admission to an examination for licensure by the Osteopathic Surgeons' Examining Board, to practice major surgery in Pennsylvania. Internship.

Section 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby suspended during the period this act shall remain in effect. Inconsistent acts repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately upon final enactment. Act effective immediately.

AN ACT

To enable tax collectors and receivers of taxes, in counties of the sixth class, to make return to the county commissioners of unpaid taxes assessed on seated lands for certain years, and validating the liens of such taxes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Taxes.

Section 1. Whenever any tax collector or receiver of taxes in any county of the sixth class shall have failed or neglected to make return to the county commissioners of taxes assessed and levied against seated lands for the years one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine or one thousand nine hundred and forty, within the time required by law, the tax collector or receiver may legally and validly make return of such taxes in the manner provided by law for such return, at any time within six months after this act takes effect, and the liens of any taxes for said years so returned under the authority of this act, shall be valid and are hereby ratified and confirmed, and a Sixth class county.
Tax collector or receiver may legally make return within six months after act, of unpaid taxes on seated lands.
