

Section 4. The provisions of this act shall become effective immediately upon final enactment; and shall remain in effect until the termination of the present national emergency proclaimed by the President of the United States and for one year thereafter.

AN ACT

To further amend section 903 of the act, approved the tenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," by clarifying the provision allowing directors expenses at annual conventions and special meetings.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

"Public School Code of 1949."

Section 1. Section 903 of the act, approved the tenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," as amended by the act, approved the second day of May, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 804), is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 903, act of March 10, 1949, P. L. 30, as amended by act of May 2, 1949, P. L. 804, further amended.

Section 903. Expenses at Annual Conventions and Special Meetings.—It shall be the duty of school directors in each county to attend such annual convention of school directors called by the county superintendent. Each school director attending the annual convention or any special meeting duly called shall receive, for his necessary expenses, the sum of eight dollars (\$8) per day for each day's attendance, and mileage at the rate of six cents (6c) per mile for the distance necessary to be traveled in going to and from such convention or special meeting. Said amount shall be paid by an order drawn on the treasurer of the school district in which he acts as school director. No school director shall be paid for more than two (2) days at any annual convention [or special meeting] *nor more than two (2) days at special meetings.*
