Section 2. The provisions of this act shall become effective immediately upon final enactment. Act effective immediately.

AN ACT

To repeal the act, approved the fifteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred thirty-five (Pamphlet Laws 1006), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, to sell and convey three contiguous parcels of land."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Real property.

Section 1. The act, approved the fifteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred thirty-five (Pamphlet Laws 1006), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, to sell and convey three contiguous parcels of land," is hereby repealed. Act of July 15, 1935, P. L. 1006, repealed.

AN ACT

To further amend section 5 of the act, approved the eleventh day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 565), entitled "An act providing compensation to certain persons who served in the military or naval forces of the United States or of any of her allies during World War II; providing the method of making payment to representatives of persons who, because of death or incapacity, cannot personally receive compensation; imposing certain duties on the Adjutant General; making an appropriation, and providing penalties," by extending the time during which applications may be filed for veterans' compensation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 5 of the act, approved the eleventh day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 565), entitled "An act providing compensation to certain persons who served in the military or naval forces of the United States or of any of her "World War II Veterans' Compensation Act."
