AN ACT

To amend the act, approved the eighth day of May, one thousand nine hundred seven (Pamphlet Laws 184, Number 146), entitled "An act to further remove the disability of a wife in testifying in cases where the husband is a party," by making husband competent witness in rebuttal under certain circumstances.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of the act, approved the eighth day of May, one thousand nine hundred seven (Pamphlet Laws 184, Number 146), entitled "An act to further remove the disability of a wife in testifying in cases where the husband is a party," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That in all civil actions brought by *either* the husband *or* wife, *either the husband* or the wife shall be a competent witness in rebuttal, when *his or* her character or conduct is attacked upon the trial thereof, but only in regard to the matter of *his or* her character or conduct.

AN ACT

To amend Article V of the act, approved the tenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," by authorizing boards of school directors and boards of public education to pay the compensation of professional employes employed as exchange teachers.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Article V of the act, approved the tenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," is hereby amended by adding, at the end thereof, the following new section:

Section 522. Payments of Salaries of Professional Employes Granted Leaves of Absence as Exchange Teachers Authorized.—Any board of public education
