AN ACT

To amend section 1 of the act, approved the twenty-eighth day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 983), entitled "An act to ascertain and appoint the fees to be received by the several prothonotaries of the courts of common pleas of the Commonwealth in counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; to provide the time of paying the same; and to repeal all acts inconsistent herewith," by increasing certain filing fees and providing for additional fees.

Fees of prothonotaries.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. So much as fixes fees for entering judgments and satisfactions of section 1 of the act, approved the twenty-eighth day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 983), entitled "An act to ascertain and appoint the fees to be received by the several prothonotaries of the courts of common pleas of the Commonwealth in counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; to provide the time of paying the same; and to repeal all acts inconsistent herewith," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The fees to be received by the several prothonotaries of the courts of common pleas of this Commonwealth in counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes shall be as follows:

* * * • •

Entering judgment on bond and warrant of attorney upon confession by defendant for want of an appearance, plea or want to an answer, or affidavit of defense, or sufficient answer, or affidavit of defense on verdict, demurrer, including judgment index entry, not more than three names, [\$2.00] \$3.00, for each additional name, 50 cents.

The fee for services not herein specially provided for shall be the same as for similar services: Provided, That the fees hereinbefore *enumerated shall be exclusive of any State tax now levied or that may hereafter be levied.

Section 2. The provisions of this act shall become effective on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred fifty-four.
