

agent or consignee shall be exempt from the duty of paying pilotage, or half pilotage, or any penalty whatsoever in case of her neglect or refusal to do so.

Effective date.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in ten days.

AN ACT

Amending the act of June twenty-second, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," changing a route in Beaver County by abandoning part thereof.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route established by the act of June twenty-second, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," is amended to read:

Route 04070. Beginning at a point on [the Gringo Road] *Route 445* about .25 of a mile west of Route 76; thence in a westerly direction to a point near Independence; thence in a westerly direction to [a point on the Raccoon-Independence Township line near Service Creek; thence along Service Creek to an intersection with route 115,] *the southern terminus of Route 04050*, in Beaver County, a distance of about [7.0] 4.0 miles.
