Amending the act of June twenty-four, one thousand nine hun-dred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1206), entitled "An act con-cerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," author-izing the township officers of two or more counties to form joint county associations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Penn- The First Class Township Code. sylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section six hundred ten, act of June Section 610, act of June 24, 1931, twenty-four, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1206), known as "The First Class Township Code." reenacted and amended May twenty-1949, P. L. 1955, twenty-four, one thousand the first class Township Code." reenacted and amended May twenty-Township Code," reenacted and amended May twentyseven, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 1955), is amended to read:

Section 610. Formation of County Associations: Meetings.-County associations of township officers may be formed in the respective counties, or the township officers of two or more counties may form a joint county association. Such associations, when formed, shall hold annual or semiannual conventions at the county seats of the respective counties, or some other suitable place within the county, for the purpose of considering and discussing questions and subjects pertaining to the best methods for the construction, improvement, and maintenance of the public highways and bridges, and the administration of township governments.
