conveyed to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by Isaac J. Booth et al. and designated Parcel "A" on Plan prepared by Clifford E. Garner, Registered Architect.

The conveyance shall be made under and subject to all easements, servitudes and rights of others, including but not confined to streets, roadways, and right of any telephone, telegraph, water, electric, gas or pipe line companies, as well as under and subject to any estates or tenancies vested in third persons, whether or not appearing of record, for any portion of the land or improvements erected thereon.

Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice, and shall be executed by the Secretary of Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 3. All moneys received from the sale of the land shall be deposited in the Motor License Fund.

AN ACT

Amending the act of June one, one thousand nine hundred thirtythree (Pamphlet Laws 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," changing or deleting certain routes and adding certain new routes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following routes established by section two, act of June one, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," and its amendments, are deleted as indicated, or amended to read:

[Route 06183. Extending Route 06183.—Beginning at a point on the Spring Township-West Lawn Borough line, thence northerly on a borough street to a point on Route 149, in the Borough of West Lawn, Berks County, a distance of about .05 of a mile.]

Deed of conveyance, after approval of Department of Justice, to be executed by Department of Property and Supplies.

Proceeds to be deposited in Motor License Fund.

State highways.

Section 2, act of June 1, 1933, P. L. 1172, deleted or amended.

Bangor Borough

[Traffic Route 132;] Legislative Route 48035. Extending Route 48035.—Beginning at a point on the Bangor Borough- *[Washington Township line] Roseto Borough line on the old Lehigh and New England Railroad right of way, thence in a southerly direction [on Main Street] over the old Lehigh and New England Railroad right of way and First Street to the intersection [of Legislative Route 165, at Market and Main Streets,] with Route 48036 at First Street and Broadway, in the Borough of Bangor, Northampton County, a distance of about [.82] 0.80 of a mile.

Roseto Borough

[Traffic Route 132;] Legislative Route 48035. Extending Route 48035.—Beginning at a point at the Washington Township-Roseto Borough line on Roseto Street, thence in a southerly direction over [an unnamed street] Roseto Street across Columbus Street, thence southerly over the old Lehigh and New England Railroad right of way to the Roseto Borough- [Washington Township line] Bangor Borough line, [tying in with Legislative Route 48035] in Roseto Borough, Northampton County, a distance of about [.11] 0.53 of a mile.

Pleasantville Borough

[Route 60074. Extending Route 60074.—Beginning at a point on the Pleasantville Borough-Oil Creek Township line, thence in a northerly direction on Main Street to a point on Route 89 at Main and State Streets, in the Borough of Pleasantville, Venango County, a distance of about 0.4 of a mile.]

Starrucca Borough

[Route 63108. Extending Route 63108.—Beginning at a point on the eastern side of Starrucca Borough, thence westerly on a borough street to a point on Route 63058, in the Borough of Starrucca, Wayne County, a distance of about 1.5 miles.]

Route 02247. Extending Route 02247.—Beginning at a point on the Penn Township-Verona Borough line, thence over Allegheny River Boulevard to a point on Route 02196, in the Borough of Oakmont, Allegheny County, a distance of about .75 of a mile.

Carnegie Borough

Route 02253. Beginning at a point on Chestnut Street, Borough of Carnegie, State Highway Route 02038 at its intersection with Ridge Avenue, thence over Ridge Avenue to Forest Avenue, thence over Forest Avenue to the easterly intersection of Grand View Avenue with Forest Avenue, thence over Grand View Avenue with intersection with Summit Street, thence over Summit Street to Chestnut Street State Highway Route 02038, in the Borough of Carnegie, Allegheny County, a distance of about .5 of a mile.

Route 02254. Beginning at the end of Ramp E connecting Route 765 to Jane Street, thence over Jane Street to Chestnut Street, thence over Chestnut Street to the intersection with Main Street (Route 108), in Carnegie Borough, Allegheny County, a distance of about .13 of a mile.

Route 02255. Beginning at the end of Ramp A connecting Route 765 to Lydia Street, thence over Lydia Street to Washington Avenue (Route 108), in Carnegie Borough, Allegheny County, a distance of about .19 of a mile.

Route 02256. Beginning at the end of Ramp B, connecting Route 765 to Academy Street, thence over Academy Street to Washington Avenue (Route 108), in Carnegie Borough, Allegheny County, a distance of about .16 of a mile.

Monaca Borough

Route 04126. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route 04015 and Marshall Road, thence in an easterly direction over Marshall Road to the intersection of Marshall Road and Allaire Avenue, thence in a northerly and easterly direction over Allaire Avenue and Colonial Street to the intersection with Beaver Avenue, in Monaca Borough, Beaver County, a distance of about 1.6 miles.

Laureldale Borough

Route 06212. Beginning at a point on the west borough line of Laureldale, thence easterly over Elizabeth Avenue to the east borough line, in the Borough of Laureldale, Berks County, a distance of about 1.1 miles.

Tyrone Borough

Route 07066. Beginning at a point on Legislative Route 55 approximately 0.5 mile south of the Borough of Tyrone, in Snyder Township, thence in a northeasterly direction on Clay Avenue in Tyrone Borough, thence northeasterly to a point at the intersection of Adams Avenue and Oak Street, Legislative Route 07032, in the Borough of Tyrone, Blair County, a distance of approximately 2.2 miles.

Tullytown Borough

Route 09169. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route 150 and Township Road #333, thence in an easterly direction along Township Road #333 to Ramp P of said Legislative Route 150, in the Borough of Tullytown, Bucks County, a distance of about .10 of a mile.

Quakertown Borough

Route 09170. Beginning at a point on Route 386 at East Broad and Branch Streets, thence over Branch and Third Streets to Route 386 at Third and West Broad Streets, in the Borough of Quakertown, Bucks County, a distance of about .10 of a mile.

Spangler Borough

Route 11100. Beginning at the intersection of the Spangler Borough line and 12th Street, thence in a southerly direction over 12th Street in Spangler Borough to the intersection with Legislative Route 62, in Cambria County, a distance of about 0.55 of a mile.

Westmont Borough

Route 11101. Beginning at the intersection of Township Route No. 356 (Goucher Street) and the Westmont Borough line, thence in a southerly direction over Goucher Street, in Westmont Borough to Station 41 +02 on Legislative Route 11011, in Cambria County, a distance of about 0.47 of a mile.

West Chester Borough

Route 15242. Beginning at a point on Legislative Route 135 at the intersection of High and Market Streets, thence easterly on Market Street to the West Chester Borough line, Chester County, a distance of about .50 of a mile.

Dauphin County

Route 22079. Beginning at a point on the Middle Paxton Township line, thence southwesterly on Stony Creek Road to an intersection with Route 22004, in the Borough of Dauphin, Dauphin County, a distance of about 0.3 of a mile.

Upland Borough

Route 23126. Beginning at a point on Route 23003 at its intersection with Kerlin Street, thence southerly over Kerlin Street to the Chester City line, in the Borough of Upland, Delaware County, a distance of about .10 of a mile.

Rices Landing Borough

Route 30127. Beginning at a point on Route 30077 Spur near First Street, thence southeasterly to Route 30025 at the Cumberland Township line in the Borough of Rices Landing, Greene County, a distance of about 1.3 miles.

Indiana Borough

Route 32183. Beginning at a point in Indiana Borough, Indiana County, at the intersection of Legislative Route 68 and Carter Avenue, thence in an easterly direction along Carter Avenue to its intersection with Application Route 268, a distance of approximately 0.45 of a mile.

Archbald Borough

Route 35075. Beginning at a point at the intersection of Main Street (County Road) and Wayne Street (Legislative Route 35048) in Archbald Borough, thence southerly over Main Street for approximately .7 of a mile to the intersection of Main Street and Eynon Road (formerly Application 4717), thence westerly over Eynon Road for approximately 1.2 miles to the intersection of Eynon Road and Main Street (Legislative Route 648 extension) in the Village of Eynon, Archbald Borough, Lackawanna County, a total distance of about 1.9 miles.

Route 35076. Beginning at a point at the intersection of Betty Street and Main Street (Station 53 & 81, Legislative Route 648 extension) in the Village of Eynon, Archbald Borough, thence westerly over Betty Street to the intersection of Betty Street and Legislative Route 6 (approximately Station 324), in Lackawanna County, a distance of about .45 of a mile.

Throop Borough

Route 35077. Beginning at a point on the north line of Scranton at Boulevard Road, thence over Boulevard Road, Rebecca Street, Belman Street, Olechna Street

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and Sanderson Street to Route 168 Extension at Sanderson and Dunmore Streets, in the Borough of Throop, Lackawanna County, a distance of about 1.3 miles.

Larksville Borough

Route 40136. Beginning at a point on Route 40096 near Route 4132, thence in a northwesterly direction over Wilson Street to a point on Route 40058 near Jackson Township line, in the Borough of Larksville, Luzerne County, a distance of about 1.8 miles.

Ashley Borough

Route 40137. Beginning on State Highway Route 170 at Station 1234 + 52, thence in a northerly direction over Hazleton Street to Legislative Route 40036 at Station 294 + 35 in Ashley Borough, Luzerne County, a distance of about 0.7 of a mile.

Forty Fort and Swoyersville Boroughs

Route 40138. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route 11 Extension and Dennison Street, thence in a southerly direction over Dennison Street in the Boroughs of Swoyersville and Forty Fort to the intersection with Legislative Route 368, in Luzerne County, a distance of about 0.60 of a mile.

Nazareth Borough

Route 48104. Beginning at a point on the westerly upper Nazareth Township-Nazareth Borough line at the terminus of Township Road 520, thence in a southeasterly and easterly direction over High Street to a point on Legislative Route 48043, in Nazareth Borough, Northampton County, a distance of about 1.0 mile.

Route 48105. Beginning at a point at the intersection of North Broad Street (Legislative Route 48043) and High Street in the Borough of Nazareth, thence westerly and northwesterly over High Street to the Nazareth Borough and Upper Nazareth Township line, in Northampton County, a distance of about 0.2 of a mile.

Coudersport Borough

Route 52058. Beginning at a point on Route 103 in the Borough of Coudersport at its intersection with Willow Street, thence northeasterly on Willow Street to the Coudersport and Port Allegany Railroad, in Potter County, a distance of about 0.3 of a mile.

Elkland Borough

Route 58130. Beginning at a point on Route 103 about 0.5 mile east of the intersection with Route 58091, thence in a northerly direction to the New York State line, in Elkland Borough, Tioga County, a distance of about 0.90 of a mile.

New Eagle Borough

Route 62212. Beginning at a point on Route 181 approximately 0.5 mile northeast of the intersection of Routes 181 and 803, thence in a northeasterly direction through Carroll Township to Seventh Avenue Extension in New Eagle Borough, thence over Seventh Avenue Extension to Maple Avenue, thence over Maple Avenue to Center Avenue, thence over Center Avenue to Memorial Avenue, thence over Memorial Avenue to the intersection with Route 247, Main Street, in New Eagle Borough, Washington County, a distance of about 1.5 miles.

Roscoe Borough

Route 62113. Beginning at the western terminus of Legislative Route 62195 at the Roscoe-Allenport Borough line, thence in a westerly direction over Forlong Avenue in the Borough of Roscoe to and over the highway crossing of the Pennsylvania Railroad at 5th Street to the intersection with Township Road No. 88, in Washington County, a distance of about 0.1 of a mile.

South Greensburg Borough

Route 64270. Beginning at the intersection at Reamer Avenue and Broad Street, thence northeasterly on Broad Street and northwesterly on Huff Street to an intersection with Route 117, in the Borough of South Greensburg, Westmoreland County, a distance of about 0.67 of a mile.

Section 3. The highways established as State highways under the provisions of this act may be taken over for construction and maintenance, at any time, subsequent to the final enactment of this act when the same shall become effective, and shall be taken over not later than January 1, 1957.
