AN ACT

Amending the act of June twenty-two, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," changing or deleting certain routes, and adding certain new routes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Penn- Township roads sylvania hereby enacts as follows:

The following routes established by the Section 1. act of June twenty-two, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions: limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," and its amendments, are deleted as indicated, or amended to read:

[Route 25103. Beginning at a point on Route 25011 near Faye School; thence northerly in Franklin Township to a point on Route 25013 near Silverthorn School, in Erie County, a distance of about 2.1 miles.

[Route 25121. Beginning at a point on Route 25102 about one mile southwest of Route 25010; thence in a northerly direction through Elk Creek Township to a point on Route 25010 at Murphy's Corners, in Erie County, a distance of about 1.1 miles.]

[Route 15100. Beginning at a point at the intersection of Route 147 with the northern boundary line of West Chester Borough; thence northeasterly along said boundary line and passing through West Goshen Township to a point on Route 202 about .5 of a mile southwest of Fern Hill Station, in Chester County, a distance of about .8 of a mile.

Beginning at a point on Route 06071 Route 06183. at the Cumru-Spring Township line; thence northwest-

Beginning at an intersection with Route 36024 immediately northwest of the village of Wheatland Mills and extending in a northeasterly direction through West Lampeter and East Lampeter townships to an intersection with Route 36011 immediately south of Pequea School, in Lancaster County, a distance of about 1.6 miles.]

[Route 39104. Beginning at a point on Route 39072 about 0.2 of a mile west of the Weisenburg-Lowhill Township line; thence northwesterly through Weisenburg Township to a point on Route 39063 about 0.5 of a mile southwest of Switzer, in Lehigh County, a distance of about 1.6 miles.

Route 47026. Beginning at a point on Route 259 about one-half mile east of the Montour-Northumberland County line; thence in a southeasterly direction through Liberty Township to a point on Route 47002 about 2.5 miles east of the Montour-Northumberland County line, in Montour County, a distance of about 2.17 miles.

Route 60074. Beginning at a point on State-aid Application 2092 near Rattlesnake School; thence in a northeasterly and northerly direction through Cornplanter and Oilcreek Townships via August Corners to a point on the Pleasantville Borough line about 0.4 of a mile west of Route 60051, in Venango County, a distance of about 5.3 miles.

Route 66189. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route 66189 and Township Route 230; thence in a southerly direction through Jackson Township and North Codorus Township over Legislative Route 66189 to the intersection with Township Route 644, in York County, a distance of about 1.6 miles in Jackson Township and about 1.4 miles in North Codorus Township, or a total distance of about 3.0 miles.]

Route 23041. Beginning at a point on Darby Road in Radnor Township, and extending in an easterly direction through Radnor Township to the village of Ithan; thence continuing through Radnor Township in a northerly direction [to an intersection with Route 577, beginning again at a point on Route 142 about 0.7 of a mile north of Ithan, thence northeasterly and northerly in Radnor Township], intersecting with Routes 577 and 142, to a point on the boundary line between Delaware and Chester Counties, in Delaware County, a distance of about [3.3] 3.9 miles.

Beginning at a point on Route 267 [in] about one mile north of Whip's Cove; thence northerly in Brush Creek Township by way of Emmaville to the Village of Crystal Springs [in Brush Creek Township]; thence northeasterly through Brush Creek Township to the Village of Akersville; thence northerly to a point on Route 39 approximately one mile east of the Bedford-Fulton County line, in Fulton County, a distance of about [7.0] 11.70 miles.

Route 30065. [Beginning on Route 30003 near the G. N. Rinehart farm in Jackson Township; thence in a southwesterly direction via Elija Morris Hill to a point near Centennial Church] Beginning at the intersection with Route 30087; thence in a southerly direction to a point on Route 30004, in Aleppo Township, Greene County, a distance of about [3] 0.7 miles.

Route 34004. Beginning at Denholm Station in Milford Township, and leading southward to the Mifflin Borough line; thence from a point on the western line of Mifflin Borough, leading in a westerly direction into Licking Creek Valley [, to a road intersection], in Juniata County, a distance of about [8.75] 9.95 miles.

Route 36148. Beginning at a point on [the] Route 129 about one-half mile southeast [line] of Elizabeth-town Borough; thence in a [northeasterly] southeasterly direction through Mt. Joy Township and West Donegal Township to a point on Route [36004] 129 about 0.5 of a mile northwest of [Milton Grove] Florin, in Lancaster County, a distance of about [3.8] 3.2 miles.

Route 37080. Beginning at a point on Route 37044 about 0.1 of a mile east of the Hickory-Scott Township line; thence in a northeasterly direction through Scott and Washington Townships to a [road intersection] point on Route 246, in Lawrence County, a distance of about [2.5] 4.6 miles.

Route 39075. Beginning at a point on Route 285 in the village of Wanamaker [; thence northeast in Lynn Township, via Slateville Schoolhouse]; thence westerly to [a road intersection near] Berks County line [; thence south to], via the village of Steinsville; thence [easterly to a point on Route 285 in the Village of Wanamaker] northerly to a road intersection, in Lehigh County, a distance of about [3.8] 2.4 miles.

Route 43006. Beginning at a point on Route 238 near Clark's Corners; thence easterly in Shenango and Lackawannock Townships to a point on Route 43005 at Carbon Crossroads; thence to Strubble Corners; thence north through Greenfield, and continuing north in Lackawannock Township to a point on the dividing *line between Lackawannock and Jefferson **Townships, across State Route 74 at Charleston, and continuing north in Jefferson Township to a point of intersection with State Route 320 [at the Seth Fruit Farm], in Mercer County, a distance of about [9.4] 11.3 miles.

Bethel Townships to a point where it intersects Route 48032 near Bangor Junction, in Upper Mt. Bethel Township, in Northampton County, a distance of about 9.3 miles.

Route 48073. Beginning in the village of Riverton; thence in a general northerly direction through Upper Mount Bethel Township along the west bank of the Delaware River to a point of intersection with Legislative Route 517, in Northampton County, a distance of about [4.65] 8.65 miles.

Route 49065. Beginning at [a point on the northern boundary of Turbotville Borough; thence northerly through Lewis Township to Five Points, from Five Points, northerly through Lewis Township to] a point about 1.6 miles south of the Lycoming County line; thence westerly through Lewis Township to the intersection with State Highway Route 18 about one mile south of the Lycoming County line, in Northumberland County, a distance of about [5.3] 3.5 miles.

Route 59016. Beginning at a [road intersection about 1.5 miles north of Dry Valley Crossroads] point on Route 59012 about 2.0 miles west of Turtle Creek; thence northerly through East Buffalo Township to the intersection of State Highway Route 24 and 26 near the Lewisburg High School, in Union County, a distance of about [3.5] 2.9 miles.

Route 59037. Beginning at a point on Route [59016] 24 about [1.2] 1.5 miles south of Lewisburg, in East Buffalo Township; thence east to the Susquehanna River; thence north along the River Road to the South Lewisburg Borough line, in Union County, a distance of about [2.4] 1.3 miles.

[Route 63108. Beginning at a point on Route 63058 about .3 of a mile west of Scott Center; thence in a southwesterly direction through Scott Township to the *Starrucca Borough line, in Wayne County, a distance of about 3.1 miles.]

[Route 116. Beginning at a point on Route 116 at the intersection with Route 45058; thence in a southeasterly direction in Smithfield Township to the intersection with Route 45061, in Monroe County, a distance of about .66 of a mile.]

Route 64043. Beginning at [county road at Kingston Bridge] a point on Route 119 in the Village of Kingston, Unity Township, and extending in a general northeasterly direction to county road about 1.5 miles southwest of Derry, in Westmoreland County, a distance of about [1.8] 2.0 miles.

Route 26123. Beginning at a point on the [northern terminus of Application 1267] southern line of Dawson Borough; thence southwesterly southerly and westerly through Dunbar, Franklin and Perry Townships by way of Jefferson School and Jackson School to a point on Route 26013 about 0.40 of a mile north of the intersection of Routes 26013 and 247, in Fayette County, a distance of about [5.5] 5.6 miles.

Section 2. The act is amended by adding the following new routes:

Route 03164. Beginning at a point on Route 03024 near Bridgeburg; thence northwesterly in east Franklin Township to Route 03022 near Montgomeryville, in Armstrong County, a distance of about 3 miles.

Route 03165. Beginning at a point on Route 705 approximately 1.21 miles south of the intersection with Route 203; thence in a northerly direction to the intersection with Township Road 460, in Bethel Township, Armstrong County, a distance of about 1.47 miles.

Route 03166. Beginning at a point on Route 03120 at the intersection with Township Route 385; thence northerly in Kiskiminetas Township to a point at the intersection of said Township Route with Route 03043, in Armstrong County, a distance of approximately 1.5 miles.

BEAVER COUNTY

Route 04127. Beginning at a point on Route 76 about one mile south of Route 445; thence southeasterly in Hopewell Township to the Allegheny County line, in Beaver County, a distance of about 0.4 of a mile.

BERKS COUNTY

Route 06213. Beginning at a point on Legislative Route 157 about one mile north of Reading; thence easterly over Township Route 601 in Muhlenberg Township to Laureldale Borough at Elizabeth Avenue and from the east line of Laureldale easterly in Muhlenberg and Alsace Townships to a point on Route 06113, in Berks County, a distance of about 1.3 miles.

BUCKS COUNTY

Route 09171. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route 09015 and Township Road 379; thence in an easterly direction over Township Road 379 to the intersection with Township Road 301; thence in a southerly direction over Township Road 301 to the Pennsburg Memorial, in Falls Township, Bucks County, a distance of about 1.45 miles.

CAMBRIA COUNTY

CLINTON COUNTY

Route 18048. Beginning at a point on the Clearfield Clinton County line at Station 425 + 57 on Legislative Route 17068 in West Keating Township; thence in a northeasterly direction over Township Road 303 through West Keating Township and East Keating Township to a point on Route 18001 near the village of Keating, in Clinton County, a distance of 14.65 miles.

CRAWFORD COUNTY

Route 20159. Beginning at the intersection of Route 271 and Route 20084 known as Page's Corners; thence in an easterly direction through Bloomfield and Sparta Townships to a point on Route 20093 at Aldsdorf Corners, in Crawford County, a distance of about 2.10 miles.

CUMBERLAND COUNTY

Route 21099. Beginning at a point on Route 123 near Mohlers Church; thence easterly in Upper Allen and Lower Allen Townships to Eichelbergers Corner, in Cumberland County, a distance of about 2.75 miles.

Beginning at a point on Rural Route 32002 about 0.6 of a mile north of the Village of Tunnelton; thence in an easterly direction over Township Road #312 to connect with the road leading to the Administration Buildings of the Conemaugh Reservoir; thence northerly over Township Road #312 to a point of intersection with Township Road #437; thence northeasterly over Township Road #437 to a point of intersection with Rural Route 32015 at Station 17 + 90 State Highway Enumeration, in Conemaugh Township, Indiana County, a distance of about 3.25 miles.

JEFFERSON COUNTY

Beginning at a point on Legislative Route 33036 about .25 miles south from its intersection with Legislative Route 189; thence in a southeasterly direction to a point on Legislative Route 33089 about .3 miles east of the Bell Township and Gaskill Township line in Bell and Gaskill Townships, Jefferson County, about 2.0 miles.

JUNIATA COUNTY

Route 34064. Beginning at a point on Route 34010 about 0.2 of a mile north of the Monroe-Greenwood

Township line; thence easterly and northeasterly through Monroe Township to a point on Route 34009 at Knousetown, in Juniata County, a distance of about 2.4 miles.

LACKAWANNA COUNTY

Route 35079. Beginning at a point on Route 35006 near Cortez; thence southerly in Jefferson Township to the Wayne County line, in Lackawanna County, a distance of about 1.70 miles.

Route 35080. Beginning at a point on Route 615 Spur near Route 648; thence easterly in Greenfield Scott and Carbondale Townships to the Carbondale City line, in Lackawanna County, a distance of about 4.2 miles.

Route 35081. Beginning at its intersection with Legislative Route #665 in the village of Thornhurst, Lehigh Township; thence in a northeasterly direction through Lehigh and Clifton Townships to its intersection with Legislative Route 35045, in Lackawanna County, a distance of about 4.80 miles.

Route 35082. Being Township Road 358 partly in the Township of Ransom and partly in the Township of Newton and beginning at the intersection with Legislative Route 440 and Legislative Route 35011; thence extending in a northwesterly direction from Ransom and Newton *Townships to the Wyoming County line, in Lackawanna County; being a total distance of approximately 3.0 miles, the total distance in Ransom Township being a distance of 1.2 miles and the total distance in Newton Township being 1.8 miles.

LANCASTER COUNTY

Route 40139. Beginning at a point on Route 235 about 1.5 miles west of Koonsville; thence northerly in Huntington and Union Townships to Route 40076, in Luzerne County, a distance of about 2.2 miles.

Route 40140. Beginning at a point on Route 40120 near the Slocum-Conyngham Township line; thence in Slocum and Conyngham Townships northerly to Lilly Lake and southwesterly to Route 40120, in Luzerne County, a distance of about 0.9 of a mile.

Route 40141. Beginning at a point on Route 40044 about two miles northeast of Lewellyn's Corners; thence easterly in Bear Creek and Plains Townships to a point on Route 665, in Luzerne County, a distance of about 5.0 miles.

Route 40142. Beginning at the intersection of Route 40098 at Station 0 + 00; thence in a northerly direction past Misericordia College over former Township Route 177 to the intersection with Route 40001 at Station 0 + 00 and Route 40001 Spur at Station 50 + 11 and Route 40002, in Dallas Township, Luzerne County, a distance of about 1.1 miles.

MERCER COUNTY

Route 43114. Beginning at a point on Route 43041 about 0.2 of a mile east of the intersection with Route 43007; thence in a northeasterly direction to an intersection with Route 74 about 1.5 miles west of Mercer Borough, in East Lackawannock Township, Mercer County, a distance of about 2.5 miles.

Route 43115. Beginning at a point on Route 43081 about 0.55 miles northwest of its intersection with Route 43034; thence in a northwesterly direction through South Pymatuning Township to a point on Application 3955 about 0.95 miles southeast of the Ohio State line, in Mercer County, a distance of about 1.4 miles.

Route 43116. Beginning at a point about 0.25 mile south of the highway bridge over the New York Central Railroad on Legislative Route 82 (Traffic Route 18); thence in a westerly direction through Sugar Grove and West Salem Townships, in Mercer County, to a point on Legislative Route 206 (Traffic Route 58) about 0.9 mile north of the intersection with Route 43035, a distance of about 1.8 miles.

Route 43117. Beginning at a point on Route 43008 about 0.4 miles north of the intersection of Route 43008

and Route 74; thence in a northeasterly direction through Hickory Township to a point on Route 43091 about 0.45 miles southwest of the intersection of Route 43091 and Route 320, in Mercer County, a distance of about 1.15 miles.

MIFFLIN COUNTY

Route 57156. Beginning at a point on Route 57010 about 0.75 mile north of the Wyoming County line; thence in a westerly direction to an intersection with Route 57018, in Lathrop Township, Susquehanna County, a distance of about 1.9 miles.

Route 58131. Beginning at a point on the Potter-Tioga County line about 0.75 of a mile south of Route 58005; thence in a northeasterly direction to a point on Route 58004 through Clymer Township, in Tioga County, a distance of about 0.5 of a mile.

Route 59048. Beginning at a point on Route 59012 about 1.0 mile east of the Buffalo Township line; thence northerly in East Buffalo Township to Route 26, in Union County, a distance of about 2.1 miles.

Beginning at a point on Route 60037 approximately 0.1 miles south of the Crawford County line; thence in an easterly and southeasterly direction through Canal and Jackson Townships to an intersection with State Highway Route 90 approximately 0.11 miles north of the intersection of Routes 90 and 60038, in Cooperstown Borough, Venango County, a distance of about 5.5 miles.

WARREN COUNTY

Route 61074. Beginning at a point on Route 61037 about 1.4 miles northeast of Warren Borough; thence north in Glade Township a distance of 5280 feet or 1 mile to a point about 1 mile south of the point of intersection of the road with Route 61036 at a point about 3 of a mile east of Macolneys Corners, in Glade Township, Warren County, a distance of about 1 mile.

WASHINGTON COUNTY

Route 64274. Beginning at the intersection of Township Roads 420 and 641; thence in a northerly direction over Township Road 420 in Sewickley and North Huntingdon Townships to the intersection with Legislative Route 64094, in Westmoreland County, a distance of about 1.0 mile.

Route 66208. Beginning at the intersection of Township Route 945 and United States Route 30; thence in a northwardly direction over Township Route 945, in Springettsbury Township, to the arsenal or Whiteford Road, in York County, a distance of about 0.6 of a mile.

Effective dates.

Section 3. The highways established as State Highways under * the provisions of this act, may be taken over for construction and maintenance at any time subsequent to the final enactment of this act, when the same shall become effective, and shall be taken over not later than the first day of January, 1957.
