Section 7. (a) The calculation of mileage shall be Determination determined, annually, as of the first day of January by of mileage. the Department of Highways from reports submitted by the municipalities.

(b) The calculations involving population shall be Determination of calculation made by the Department of Highways, and shall be of population. based on the latest available official census figures [where] determined on or before the first day of January in the year the money is to be paid to the municipalities. Where the population of any municipality changes by reason of annexation, withdrawal or dissolution, the Department shall not be presumed to have notice of such change until furnished with a statement approved by all affected political subdivisions or with an order of a court of competent jurisdiction.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

## AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Highways to conduct a study and survey to determine the advisibility of constructing a bridge across the Susquehanna River between the borough of Kingston and Plains Township, both situate in Luzerne

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

The Department of Highways is hereby Department of empowered and its duty shall be to conduct a study and empowered and its duty shall be to conduct a study and thorized to make survey, at or near Church Street, in the Borough of Survey to con-Kingston, on the west side of the Susquehanna River, struct a bridge to a point between the Willes Borough of the Luzerne to a point between the Wilkes-Barre Connecting Railroad Bridge and Midvale, in Plains Township, on the east side of the river, both situate in Luzerne County, or a more suitable location in the same general area, to determine the advisability of constructing as part of the State highway system an additional bridge crossing the Susquehanna River between such political subdivisions. In such study and survey due regard shall be had to the necessity and importance of such a bridge from a traffic viewpoint as well as to the consideration of cost and feasibility of the bridge at such location.
