The notices and reports hereinbefore required by this section shall be in addition to any notices and reports such corporation or association may be required to make under the laws of this Commonwealth to the Insurance Commissioner or to any other State officer.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

Amending the act approved May 17, 1921 (P. L. 789), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to insurance; establishing an insurance department; and amending, revising, and consolidating the law relating to the licensing, qualification, regulation, examination, suspension, and dissolution of insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and certain societies and orders, the examination and regulation of fire insurance rating bureaus, and the licensing and regulation of insurance agents and brokers; the service of legal process upon foreign insurance companies, associations, or exchanges; providing penalties; and repealing existing laws," by continuing the provisions of section 211.1 in effect for a further period.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

The Insurance Department Act of 1921.

Section 1. Subsection (f) of section 211.1, act of May 17, 1921 (P. L. 789), known as "The Insurance Department Act of 1921," amended December 9, 1955 (P. L. 816), is further amended to read:

Section 211.1. Assessments to Defray Expenses of Committee on Valuation of Securities of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners.—

* * * * *

(f) This section shall become effective the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine, and shall continue in effect until and including the thirty-first day of May, one thousand nine hundred [fifty-seven] *fifty-nine*.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
