

An Act

Authorizing and directing the Department of Property and Supplies to convey to the Board of Trustees of the University of Pittsburgh a certain plot of ground and the building thereon, located adjacent to the campus of the University of Pittsburgh, for the purpose of providing additional land required by the Medical Center of the University which will include a Graduate School of Public Health *or for such other university purposes as the board of trustees may, from time to time, deem in the best interests of the University.* Title.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the University of Pittsburgh, upon assumption of possession of the property herein described and authorized for conveyance to the University under the conditions herein set forth, shall agree to use the property for the extension of its Medical Center which will include the Graduate School of Public Health *or for such other university purposes as the board of trustees may, from time to time, deem in the best interests of the University.*

Broader purposes for use by grantee.

AN ACT

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing supervisors to annually appropriate money for certain nursing services.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

The Second Class Township Code.

Section 1. Section 702, act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P. L. 1481), is amended by adding, at the end thereof, a new clause to read:

Section 702, act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, reenacted and amended July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481, further amended by adding a new clause LVII.

Section 702. Supervisors to Exercise Powers.—The corporate powers of townships of the second class shall be exercised by the township supervisors. Where no specific authority is given for the expenditures incident to the exercise of any power hereinafter conferred, or where no specific fund is designated from which such expenditures shall be made, appropriations for such expenditures shall be made only from the general township

fund. In addition to the duties imposed upon them by section 516 hereof, they shall have power—

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•*LVII. Appropriations for Community Nursing Services.*—*To appropriate money annually towards any nonprofit associations or corporations which provide community nursing services, in recognition of their services in the control of communicable disease, the immunization of children, the operation of child health centers (Well-Baby Clinics), instructive visits to mothers of new babies beginning in the prenatal period and family health guidance, including nutrition, detection and correction of defects.*

Act effective immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," changing or deleting certain routes and adding certain new routes.

State highways in certain boroughs and incorporated towns.

Section 2, act of June 1, 1933, P. L. 1172, certain routes deleted or amended.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following routes established by section 2, act of June 1, 1933 (P. L. 1172), entitled "An act establishing certain streets in boroughs and incorporated towns as State highways, and providing for their construction and maintenance at the expense of the Commonwealth," and its amendments, are deleted as indicated or amended to read:

Spangler Borough

Route 11100.

[Route 11100. Beginning at the intersection of the Spangler Borough line and 12th Street; thence in a southeasterly direction over 12th Street, in Spangler Borough, to the intersection with Legislative Route 62, in Cambria County, a distance of about 0.55 of a mile.]

Atglen Borough

Route 15062,
Spur E.

Route 15062, Spur E. Beginning at a point at the intersection of [Liberty Street, Route 15063, and West Main Street, Route 15062 Spur E] Valley Avenue;
