The Department of Welfare may, with the approval Department of Welfare authof the Governor, arrange for the acquisition of the lands orized to make or the construction of the clinics by the General State arrangements. Authority, or both acquisition and construction may, with the approval of the Governor, be arranged for with the General State Authority.

## AN ACT

To amend the act approved the twenty-second day of August, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1372), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, to acquire a tract of land comprised of three smaller tracts, together with the improvements thereon, erected in Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, consisting of approximately seven acres, for use of the State Farm Products Show Commission; and making an appropriation," by increasing the appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Penn- Real property. sylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section three of the act, approved the August 22, 1953, day of August, one thousand nine hun-P. L. 1372, Section 1. twenty-second day of August, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three (Pamphlet Laws 1372), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, to acquire a tract of land comprised of three smaller tracts, together with the improvements thereon, erected in Susquehanna Township, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, consisting of approximately seven acres, for use of the State Farm Products Show Commission; and making an appropriation," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The sum of [seventy-five thousand dollars Appropriation. (\$75,000)] ninety-one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$91,250), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Property and Supplies for the payment of the acquisition of such tracts of land and expenses incidental thereto, including the completion of an abstract of title thereon.
