

(1) The employes eligible for insurance under the policy shall be all of the employes of the employer, or all of any class or classes thereof determined by conditions pertaining to their employment. The policy may provide that the term "employes" shall include the employes of one or more subsidiary corporations, and the employes, individual proprietors, and partners of one or more affiliated corporations, proprietors or partnerships if the business of the employer and of such affiliated corporations, proprietors or partnerships is under common control through stock ownership or contract. The policy may provide that the term "employes" shall include the individual proprietor or partners if the employer is an individual proprietor or a partnership. The policy may provide that the term "employes" shall include retired employes. *A policy issued to insure employes of a public body may provide that the term "employes" shall include elected or appointed officials.*

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Forests and Waters, with the approval of the Governor, to convey to the City of Erie certain lands covered with water situate in the City and County of Erie, Pennsylvania.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Real Property.

Section 1. The Department of Forests and Waters, acting on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized to convey to the City of Erie the following \* described **\*\*tract of land covered with water:** Department of Forests and Waters authorized, with approval of Governor, to convey certain property in Erie County.

All that certain tract of land in the City and County of Erie, Pennsylvania, beginning at the northeast corner of a fifty acre tract, being known as Tract No. 27 in the Third Section of the town of Erie as finally laid out and sold; thence by the north line of fifty acre tracts numbering from Tract No. 27 through Tract No. 39, inclusive, following as nearly as may be the shore of the Bay of Presque Isle, South 63° 10' West nine thousand two hundred sixty-six (9,266) feet to a post, the northwest corner of fifty acre Tract No. 39 and the northeast corner of Reserve Tract Number 5; thence North 27° 15' West Description.

\*(it being the east line of Reserve Tract Number 5 produced) fourteen hundred (1,400) feet, more or less, to the United States Harbor Line extended; thence by the United States Harbor Line extended North 62° 35' \*\*East nine thousand two hundred sixty-six (9,266) feet to a point in the United States Harbor Line; thence South 27° 15' East seventeen hundred (1,700) feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, being the water property in the Bay of Presque Isle, in front, adjoining and north of the Third Section of the town of Erie as originally laid out.

Approval of conveyance by Department of Justice required.

Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of Forests and Waters in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Control of property.

Section 3. The water property conveyed to the City of Erie under the authority of this act shall be controlled by the City of Erie or its designated agency for the development of the Port of Erie.

Specific repeal.

Section 4. The act of May 27, 1921, P. L. 1180, entitled "An act dedicating certain lands in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, situated in the City and County of Erie, to public use as an historical memorial and public State park; aiding in the development of the harbor of Erie; and creating a commission to manage and control said lands and \*\*\*said harbor improvements; empowering said commission to purchase or receive by gift other lands for the purpose of this act; providing for the appointment of members of said commission, and that the Secretary of Internal Affairs and the Commissioner of Fisheries shall be ex officio members thereof; defining the duties and powers of said commission; excepting rights and privileges in said lands heretofore granted; and making an appropriation," is repealed in so far as it is inconsistent with the provisions of this act.
