AN ACT

Amending the act of May 28, 1937 (P. L. 1019), entitled "An act relating to statutory laws; prescribing an enacting clause for statutes; fixing the effective date and time of statutes hereafter enacted; providing for notice of application for local and special legislation, for the correction of errors in statutes, and for the printing and publication of statutes; prescribing rules for the interpretation of statutes; defining certain words and phrases when used in statutes; and prescribing rules for the construction and operation of amendments, re-enactments and repeals of statutes," changing the computation of time in certain respects.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Statutory Construction Act.

Section 1. Section 38, act of May 28, 1937 (P. L. 1019), known as the "Statutory Construction Act," is amended to read:

Section 38, act of May 28, 1937, P. L. 1019, amended.

Section 38. Computation of Time.—When any period of time is referred to in any law, such period in all cases, except as otherwise provided in sections thirty-nine and forty, shall be so computed as to exclude the first and include the last day of such period. Whenever the last day of any such period shall fall on *Saturday* or *Sunday*, or on any day made a legal holiday by the laws of this Commonwealth or of the United States, such day shall be omitted from the computation.

Section 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to any matter or proceeding which has not been finally concluded when this act takes effect.

Application.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
