Compensation and Mileage. - Every school director attending a convention for the election of a county superintendent shall be paid the sum of [eight dollars ( $\$ 8$ )] ten dollars ( $\$ 10$ ) per day, and mileage at the rate of [six cents ( $6 \phi$ )] seven cents ( $7 \phi$ ) per mile for each mile necessary \%o be traveled between the county seat and the home of such director, such sum to be paid by the school district in. which the director resides, by a proper order drawn on the treasurer of such district.
