AN ACT

Amending the act of May 9, 1949 (P. L. 919), entitled "An act designating certain clerks of courts agents of the Commonwealth in the collection and transmission of fines, forfeited recognizances and other forfeitures imposed, lost or forfeited into any court for the use of the Commonwealth; prescribing their powers and duties; fixing their compensation; and providing procedures for transmission and settlement of certain moneys," changing the day for rendering certain returns to the Department of Revenue.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Clerks of courts.

Section 1. Section 3, act of May 9, 1949 (P. L. 919), entitled "An act designating certain clerks of courts agents of the Commonwealth in the collection and transmission of fines, forfeited recognizances and other forfeitures imposed, lost or forfeited into any court for the use of the Commonwealth; prescribing their powers and duties; fixing their compensation; and providing procedures for transmission and settlement of certain moneys," is amended to read: Section 3, act of  
May 9, 1949,  
P. L. 919,  
amended.

Section 3. On the first Monday *after the first Tuesday* of each month it shall be the duty of every clerk of court to render to the Department of Revenue, under oath or affirmation, return of all fines received during the preceding month for the use of the Commonwealth, under the provisions of this act, and to pay the same into the State Treasury through the Department of Revenue, less any compensation herein allowable. Monthly return
