ing his term in connection with the duties of his office, in the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000), annually; the salary and expenses to be payable in equal monthly installments on the first of the month with the exception that the installments due December first of each even year shall be added to and payable with the installments due January first of the following year.

Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies to sell and convey 10.0478 acres, more or less, of land situate in East Allen Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania, with the approval of the Governor.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Penn- Real property. sylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to sell at public sale to the highest bidder the following described tract of land situate in the Township of East Allen, County of Northampton and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:
