AN ACT

Repealing section 6, act of June 30, 1947 (P. L. 1154), entitled, as amended, "An act to regulate the manufacture, sale, transportation, possession, use and advertising of oleomargarine, butterine and other similar products, and to prohibit the sale, possession or use thereof in certain cases; to provide for license fees to be paid by manufacturers, wholesale and retail dealers, and by proprietors of hotels, restaurants, dining-rooms, and boarding-houses; to prevent and punish fraud and deception in such manufacture, sale, use and advertising; to prescribe penalties and punishment for violation of this act, and the means and method of procedure for its enforcement; to regulate certain matters of evidence in such procedure; and to prescribe certain powers and duties of the Department of Agriculture," relating to the keeping of records.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Oleomargarine or butterine, etc.

Section 1. Section 6, act of June 30, 1947 (P.
