tenancies vested in third persons, whether or not appearing of record, for any portion of the land or improvements erected thereon.

Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Approval and execution.

Section 3. All moneys received from the sale of the Disposition of land shall be deposited in the Motor License Fund.

AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P. L. 58), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors," making a correction for a typographical error.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 618. Suspension of Licenses or Operating Privileges .--

(a.1) The secretary shall suspend the operating privileges of any person, with or without a hearing before the secretary or his representative, upon receiving proceedings in which such person pleaded guilty, entered a plea of nolo contendere, or was found guilty by a judge or jury of violating the provisions of section [1040] 1041 of this act.
