Creation of administrative boards in Depart-ment of Welfare.

There [is] are hereby created [a] three Section 4. departmental administrative [board] boards in The Department of Public Welfare to be known as the "Board of Trustees of The Western Youth Development [Center at Canonsburg | Centers," the "Board of Trustees of The Central Youth Development Centers," and the "Board of Trustees of The Eastern Youth Development Centers." The [board] boards shall receive into custody in [The Youth Development Center at Canonsburg, or any annex thereof, the State facilities assigned to their jurisdiction by the Department of Public Welfare for care, guidance and control, [any minor] those minors under the age of eighteen (18) years [properly] committed by [law] Juvenile Courts. Such minors may remain committed until they attain the age of twentyone (21) years.

AN ACT

Boards of Trustees of State Institu-Section 401. tions.—The boards of trustees of each of the State institutions hereinafter mentioned shall consist of nine members, and the head of the department having supervision over the institution ex officio.

The terms of each member of each such board shall be six years, and until his successor is appointed and qualified.

The terms of the first three members of all boards, the members of which now serve for terms of four years, appointed by the Governor on or after the third Tuesday of January, 1959, shall expire on the third Tuesday of January, 1961. The terms of the next three members appointed shall expire on the third Tuesday of January, 1963. The terms of the next three members appointed shall expire on the third Tuesday of January, 1965. Their successors and all members of all boards, appointed to succeed members who have served six year terms, shall be appointed for terms of six years from the date of the expiration of the preceding term. Vacancies happen-

ing before the expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired term.

Five members of any such board shall constitute a quorum.

Each such board shall annually elect a president and vice-president from among its members, and a secretary and treasurer who need not be members of the board. The secretary and treasurer may be the same person.
