AN ACT

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing supervisors to transact business other than organizing as a board at meetings on the first Monday of January, and validating certain actions taken and business transacted at such previous organization meetings.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

The Second Class Township Code.

Section 1. Section 511, act of May 1, 1933 (P. L. 103), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P. L. 1481) and amended May 20, 1957 (P. L. 174), is amended to read:

Section 511, act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, reenacted and amended July 10, 1947, P. L. 1481, and amended May 20, 1957, P. L. 174, further amended.

Section 511. Organization Meeting; Appointment of Secretary and Treasurer.—The supervisors of each township shall meet, at a convenient time and place, on the first Monday in January of each year. If the first Monday is a legal holiday, the meeting shall be held the first day following. At such time the township supervisors shall organize as a board by electing one of their number as chairman. The board shall appoint a treasurer and a secretary, who shall be the same person, and who may or may not be a member of the board, except where the board selects a trust company or a banking institution to act as treasurer, in which case it shall elect an individual as secretary.

The meeting under this section may be considered as a regular monthly meeting for the transaction of such business as comes before it. The first order of business at this meeting shall be organization of the board. Any action taken or business transacted other than organization of the supervisors as a board at any organization meeting held prior to the effective date of this amending act, which is invalid for the reason that the action was taken or business transacted at an organization meeting, is hereby validated and confirmed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
