AN ACT

Providing that probation officers shall have the power of peace officers in the performance of their duties.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Penn- Probation svlvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Probation officers heretofore or hereafter police powers and authority throughout the Common-wealth to arrest with or without werrant whit process, any person on probation or parole under the supervision of said court for failing to report as required by the terms of his probation or parole or for any other violation of his probation or parole.
