Scranton, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby convene the General Assembly in extraordinary session, to meet in the Capitol, at Harrisburg, on Wednesday, March 2, 1966, at 10:00 p.m., to consider legislation upon the subject of Congressional Reapportionment.
