The term "a day other than Sunday" as used herein shall mean any consecutive twenty-four hour period.

Each separate sale or offer to sell shall constitute a separate offense. Information charging violations of this section shall be brought within seventy-two hours after the commission of the alleged offense and not thereafter.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

SB 67

Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P. L. 323), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing certain clerks of orphans' courts to appoint solicitors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of August 9, 1955 (P. L. 323), known as "The County Code," is amended by adding after section 1315, a new section to read:

Section 1316. Solicitors to Clerks of Orphans' Courts in Counties of the Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Classes.—In all counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes, the clerk of the orphans' court except those who are also the register of wills may appoint one person, learned in the law, as his solicitor. The solicitor shall advise the clerk of the orphans' court on all legal matters that may be submitted to him, and conduct all litigation connected with the clerk's office when requested to do so by the clerk of the orphans' court.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
