Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," deleting one route and part of another in Hamlin and Lafayette Townships, McKean County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following Routes in McKean County established by section 2, act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," and its amendments, ¹ are amended or deleted to read as follows:

McKean County

Route 42005. Beginning at Mount Jewett Borough; thence northeasterly and northwesterly through Hamlin Township and Lafayette

Township, by way of Kushequa, to [a point on Route 42006 near Mount Alton,] an intersection with Route 42036 in McKean County,

a distance of about [7.55] 5.15 miles.

[Route 42040. Beginning at a point on Route 97 near the Lafayette-Hamlin Township line; thence southeasterly and northeasterly through Lafayette and Hamlin Townships, via Riterville, to a point on Route 42005 at its intersection with Route 42036, in McKean County, a distance of about 3.6 miles.]

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
