

to function, such appropriation may be made to the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War, Daughters of Union Veterans of the Civil War, or, in the absence of such [order] orders, to a duly constituted organization which conducts the decorating of graves of Union Veterans of the Civil War.

(c) Such payments shall be made to defray actual expenses only. Before any payment is made the organization receiving the same shall submit verified accounts of their expenditures.

HB 189

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (P. L. 1656), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," clarifying the provisions of existing law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3006, act of February 1, 1966 (P. L. 1656), known as "The Borough Code," is amended to read:

Section 3006. [Sheriff's Deeds;] Registry Required Before Recording.—The sheriffs of the respective counties in which any such borough is situated shall present for registry the deeds of all properties within such borough sold by them at judicial sales; and the recorders of deeds of such counties shall not admit for record any deed of any property in such borough, bearing dates subsequent to the enactment of an ordinance providing for the establishment of such registry, unless the same shall first have been duly stamped as herein provided.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
