## AN ACT

### HB 957

Amending the act of July 15, 1957 (P. L. 901), entitled "An act giving cities of the third class the right and power to adopt one of several plans of optional charters and to exercise the powers and authority of local self-government subject to certain restrictions and limitations; providing procedures for such adoption and defining the effect thereof," further providing for the appointments or the power exercised by the city manager.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 521, act of July 15, 1957 (P. L. 901), known as the "Optional Third Class City Charter Law," is amended to read: Section 521. Any provision of general law now or hereafter en-

acted conferring the appointing power or other power upon the mayor

or other executive head of the city shall be construed as meaning the city manager in a city governed under this article, and the appointments or the power exercised by the city manager in accordance with such provision shall be classified and given the same force and effect as if executed by the official named therein.
