Amending the act of July 15, 1957 (P. L. 901), entitled "An act giving cities of the third class the right and power to adopt one of several plans of optional charters and to exercise the powers and authority of local self-government subject to certain restrictions and limitations; providing procedures for such adoption and defining the effect thereof," permitting city council to hold its organization meeting on the first day after a holiday.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 408, act of July 15, 1957 (P. L. 901), known as the "Optional Third Class City Charter Law," is amended to read: Section 408. On the first Monday of January following the regular municipal election, the members of council shall assemble at the usual place of meeting and organize and elect a president of the council from among its members, who shall preside at its meetings and perform such other duties as council may prescribe. If the first Monday is a

legal holiday, the meeting shall be held on the first day following. In the absence of the president, the council shall elect a temporary presiding officer.

L. 323), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for the classification of counties and the establishment of prothonotary's fees.
