cept as in this article otherwise provided, for taking fish from the waters within this Commonwealth, except the following:

(c) Any species, when fishing only through holes in the ice, not more than five tip-ups or other legal devices. The holes in the ice shall not be larger than ten inches between the <sup>1</sup> farthest points as measured in any direction.

AN ACT

HB 884

Amending the act of June 24, 1931, (P. L. 1206), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing for the appropriation of money for rescue and life saving services.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause XXXIV of section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P. L. 1206), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P. L. 1955), is amended to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power—

XXXIV. [Motor] Ambulances and Rescue and Life Saving Services. To acquire and to operate and maintain [a motor ambulance] motor vehicles for the purposes of conveying sick and injured persons of such township and the vicinity to and from hospitals, and, for such purposes, to appropriate and expend moneys of the township or to appropriate money annually towards a non-profit community ambulance and rescue and life saving service.
